# Test systems and routes of administration

#### **Test Species**

- Rats, mice, guinea pigs, rabbits, hamsters
- Dogs and Non-Human Primates, available through our collaborating test facilities

#### **Routes of Administration**

- Oral (gavage & dietary), dermal, inhalation, parenteral (IV/SC/IM/ID)
- Other Intranasal, ocular, intra-vitreal, otic, intra-articular;
- Implantation

# Mutagenicity

- In-vitro / in-vivo studies
- Gene mutation Bacterial (Ames test); mammalian cells
- Chromosome Aberration; Micronucleus Test

#### **Acute Toxicity**

- Acute oral, dermal, inhalation toxicity;
- Acute dermal & eye irritation/ corrosion; Mucous membrane irritation;
- Skin sensitization Buehler, GPMT, LLNA

# Subchronic / Chronic Toxicity / Carcinogenicity

- 7-day (DRF), 14-day, 28-day, 90-day, 180-day and 12-month repeat dose studies
- 18-month/24-month carcinogenicity bioassays
- Implantation studies on medical devices
